Services Offered

WIC is the special supplement food program for women, Infant and Children established by public law 92-43 3, and carried out by the United States Department of Agriculture. WIC helps lower income pregnant and breastfeeding women, who recently had a baby, infants, and children who are at health risk due to inadequate nutrition.

Services Include

1. Supplement highly nutritious foods such as iron fortified; milk eggs, peanut butter, juice, cereals and beans.
2. Nutrition Education
3. Referral to prenatal and pediatric health care and human service programs (example Medicare and food stamps)
4. Immunizations can be given.

Eligibility

1. Pregnant or Breastfeeding women; women who recently had a baby; infants birth 12 months and children ages 1-5.
2. Residents of Guernsey County and border county residents who receive child development services at Guernsey County Health Department.
3. Income level of Federal Poverty Guidelines determined yearly.
4. Determined by a health professional to be at medical/nutritional risk.
