Services Offered:

Advocacy Services: Providing advocacy for persons with disabilities on both an individual and systems level.

Information and Referral: Current information on housing, transportation, assistive devices, and community resources.

Community Education: Provides speakers to civic groups, schools, churches, and public/private organizations interested in learning more about disability related issues.

Independent Living Skills Training: Provides consumers with basic life skills training that support independent living goals.

Peer Support: A self-help service that can include mobility training, coping skills, body image, personal relationships, and socialization.

Technical Assistance: Provides Section 504 and ADA training and advisory assistance to persons with disabilities, businesses, organizations, schools, and others to improve understanding, implementation, and compliance.

Cost:

Services are free. Social events may have a charge.

Eligibility:

Programs are designed for persons with disabilities and their families at any age, in the service area of Belmont, Carroll, Coshocton, Guernsey, Holmes, Jefferson, and Tuscarawas.
